To be eligible for the award, the rider must be a USDF Group or Participating Member, must be an USEF Amateur in good standing, and must receive a score of 60% or higher in the above designated class.

RULES AND GENERAL INFORMATION

1. **Dressage at Flintridge** is covered by the rules and specifications of the current US Equestrian Rule Book and will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith.
2. Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Preliminary Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A nonmember may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$30 nonmember registration fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions. 8) Opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.
3. **Amateurs and Juniors:** Amateurs are defined by the rules and specifications of the current USEF Rule Book. *All riders entering the Amateur classes must possess or have applied for an USEF Amateur Card prior to riding in the class. All riders in Amateur Divisions must present an USEF Amateur Card when picking up their number or they will not be allowed to show in the Amateur Division.* Cards may be applied for at the show office. Junior classes are open to riders under 18 years of age as of December 1, 2016. You must specify on the entry which section you are entered in, A (Am) or J (Junior). Young Riders are eligible for FEI Young Rider classes from 16-21 yrs. of age; otherwise may compete in the appropriate Jr/YR class.
4. **CONDITIONS OF ENTRY:** Every horse entered for competition will be under the control of the Horse Show Management, but the Horse Show Management will, in no case, be responsible for any loss or damage that may occur, and it shall be a condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold the Horse Show and its Directors harmless for any loss or accident to riders horse, horses or equipment which may occur from sickness, fire or otherwise.
5. **ENTRY PROCEDURES: PLEASE READ CAREFULLY!!**
 - A. **Office fee and Stabling fees:** For each horse entered, send your completed entry form, ALL FEES, class fees, stabling fees or grounds fee and a \$20 office fee for each show day entered. All Fees must *be included with your entry* Office Fees are NOT optional.
 - B. **At the Show:** No numbers will be issued without full payment and completed entries, *including signatures*. Credit Card excepted.
 - C. **Entry Acceptance:** Entries will be accepted on a first come-first serve basis until classes are filled. Entries received after classes are filled will be notified and, if desired, put on a waiting list. Those on a waiting list not getting into the show will have all fees refunded. NO PHONE entries will be accepted. All entries must be made **on official entry blanks and filled out completely as to classes, exhibitors names, addresses, phone numbers, association numbers, and signatures**. Parents or guardians must sign the official entry blank of a minor before a number will be released. **Entries close and MUST BE RECEIVED BY FRIDAY, MAY 5, 2017. www.cornerstonedressage.com**

6. **TESTS:** The Current USDF, USEF and FEI tests will be used
7. **SCRATCHES:** Exhibitors have the responsibility of informing the Show Office of their intention to scratch. Scratches before the closing date may be made for any reason and all fees will be refunded except nominating fees. If you decide to scratch any of the classes after the closing date, you must call and inform show management at (818) 841-3554 or mmmdressage@gmail.com. Scratches made after this time are liable for all unpaid entry fees and will be billed accordingly. During the show you may contact the show office at 818-952-1284. **NO REFUNDS AFTER THE CLOSING DATE FOR ANY REASON.** Riders who No-Show to their classes will be billed for all unpaid charges.. **THERE ARE NO REFUNDS FOR ANY REASON , AFTER THE CLOSING DATE OF MAY 5.**
8. **LATE ENTRIES:** All entries must be RECEIVED on or before the closing date or will be considered a late entry. Each late entry will be charged a late fee of \$50.00. Late entries will be accepted and given a ride time only as schedule permits.
9. **UNPAID CHARGES:** Any exhibitor leaving the show with an unpaid balance of entry fees or feed bill, will be billed for these charges and a \$35.00 billing fee will be added to the total due. Until these charges are settled, all future entries of rider and owner will be returned.
10. **RETURNED CHECKS:** Checks returned by the bank will be handled according to the following procedure: A 10% penalty (minimum \$25.00) will be assessed for each returned check.
11. Preliminary ride times will be emailed the week before the show and final ride times will be emailed and posted on the scoreboard at the horse show the day before. Each day the show will 12:00 pm will post the ride times for the next day. Any other changes to the schedule will be made in accordance with USEF rule GR830.5. It is the responsibility of the rider to inform the management of any time conflicts at least 24 hours before the scheduled rides. Any changes after the show starts will be charged a \$15.00 office fee.
12. **ARENAS:** 20 x 60 arenas of composition footing. Only horses entered in the show will be allowed in warm-up area. No one on foot is allowed in designated warm-ups. Lungeing is to be done ONLY in specified areas. All horses in the warm-up arenas must wear their competition numbers. All arena must be vacated while equipment is being used.

Rules Continued:

13. RIBBONS AND AWARDS: In classes where three or more riders complete the class, the winner will receive an award. If less than three, ribbons only will be given. Ribbons are awarded to fifth place

14. MANAGEMENT: Horse Show Management reserves the right to itself to interpret all questions and conditions in regard to or arising out of any incident in the show without claims for damages or recourse of any kind. All questions not covered in these rules and regulations shall be decided by the Horse Show Management; their decision will be final. The Horse Show Management reserves itself the right to refuse, accept conditionally, or to cancel any entries, disqualify riders or exhibitors, prohibit exhibition of entries and cancel award prizes, without claim to damages; to change, cancel or combine any classes, to reschedule classes after due notice to exhibitors, or to change rings or rotate judges.

15. STABLING: NO STRAW IS PERMITTED - ONLY SHAVINGS FOR BEDDING. Shavings may be ordered prior to or during the show. Portable stalls are of wood and canvas construction, 10' x 10' with Dutch doors. Stalls are \$195.00 whether used for horse, tack or feed. There are no REFUNDS on stalls.

16. FEED AND SHAVINGS: Please pre-order your Shavings and Feed orders in several days before you plan to arrive. Please call Damoor's Feed and Tack, AT (818) 242-2841. All orders must be made by 12:00 PM each day for same day delivery. **NO FEED OR BEDDING WILL BE DELIVERED ON SUNDAY**

17. HOSE/ WASHING: Do not wash horses in barn area. Please use the wash racks. We recommend that you have a garden hose available.

18. STALL CLEANING: Please deposit all manure at the far end of the barn aisles.

19. JUDGES: It is the purpose of the management to run the Horse Show at the highest possible level of sportsmanship. The Management used the utmost care to select judges with broad experience and knowledge. The judges' decisions in the show ring are their own responsibility and the Management accepts no responsibility for those decisions.

20. PROTESTS: Any exhibitor lodging a protest must first deposit \$300 for non members or \$200 for USEF members with the secretary of the show, which sum will be forfeited to the Horse Show if not sustained. All protests must be filed in writing, signed by the protester, and filed with the Show secretary within 48 hours of the occurrence of the alleged violation.

21. DOGS: Dogs must be kept on a leash in the barn areas at all times. DOGS ARE NOT ALLOWED IN WARM-UP, ARENA, VENDOR OR FOOD AREAS AT FLINTRIDGE. Stray dogs will be impounded and held for \$50 fine

22. PARKING Car Parking Violators improperly parked, including NO PARKING ZONES AND FIRE LANES, will be issued citations and/or towed from premises at the vehicle owner's expense. (U.S. Mun. Code - 80.71-4/ CA. Veh. Code 22658A)

23. OVERNIGHT PARKING: Very limited overnight parking. No water or electrical parking. Call Glenda (818) 841-3554 to see if any locations is available..

24. RAIN SCHEDULE: In the event of rain, a new time schedule will be posted for ALL rides - New ride times will be available on the day that new scheduling is warranted.

25. VEHICLES: Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s) and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Rule 6. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

26. MEDICAL WASTE: In accordance with the rules of USEF Bio-Hazardous Medical Waste containers are provided in the stable area. All exhibitors and their agents are responsible for the proper disposal of this waste.

27. HELMETS: Effective April 1, 2013, for dressage: Anyone mounted on a horse must wear protective headgear.

28. ASSUMPTION OF RISK, HOLD HARMLESS, INDEMNIFICATION, AND RELEASE AGREEMENT

1. In consideration of the use of the premises of the Flintridge Riding Club, the undersigned recognizes and agrees that participation in horse sports and horse-related activities is DANGEROUS AND HAZARDOUS, AND MAY EVEN LEAD TO PERMANENT INJURY OR DEATH. 2. 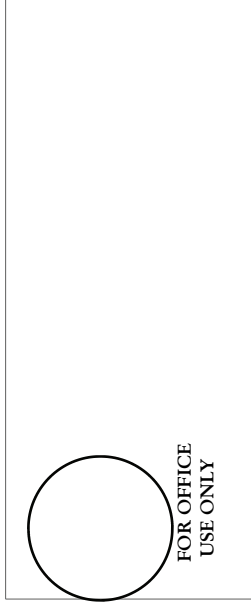
